Project of the Month

Bumbaret Scarf

in JaggerSpun Wool-Bamboo Yarn



Modified Bumbaret Scarf

Very soft and warm.

Loom needed: 4S, 12" weaving width, 10 dent reed

Yarn: JaggerSpun Wool-Bamboo (55% wool, 45% bamboo) 896 ypp

Warp yarns: Merlot, Steel, Carbon

Weft yarns: Carbon

JaggerSpun Wool-Bamboo yarn has a limited color line

Sett: 10 epi; 9 ppi

Reed: 10 dpi **Sley:** 1 per dent

Width in reed: 11.25"

Number of ends: 111 + 2 fs = 113 ends

Woven length: 80" + 8" twisted fringe (each end)

Warp length: 108" (3 yards) including loom waste

Shrinkage and take-up: 9% width 7% length

Warp Color Order: (from left)

Carbon: 30 ends + 2 fs = 32 ends

Merlot: 42 ends

Steel: 39 ends

Weaving Instructions:

Weave scarf with Carbon for 80" measured under tension.

Watch floating selvages to not have more than 3 ends together; therefore sometimes over both, then under one and/or both.

Remove from the loom and twist fringe at both ends. Fringe will be 2 groups of 3 ends.

Machine washed on wool cycle in warm (95 degree) water, medium spin with Seventh Generation Free and Clear soap.

Laid flat to dry; trimmed ends of fringe.

To make weaving easier and have better selvages, weave a 6H draft adding 4 ends of Carbon on each side in plain weave instead of floating selvages.

Project Cost:

JaggerSpun Wool-Bamboo is \$30 for ½ pound cone.

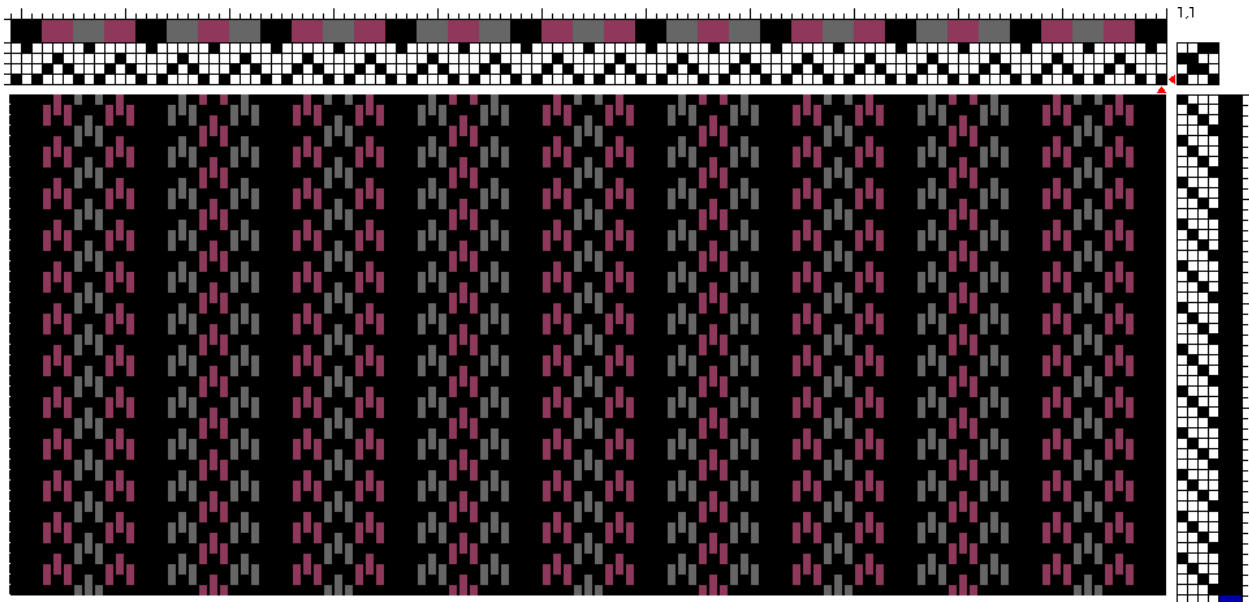
Available colors: Carbon, Hazelnut, Merlot, Midnight, Nutmeg, Steel

The scarf used 0.65 lbs. of yarn.
